Brief overview of health, well-being and risk factors in the city of Hull

It is estimated that 257,710 people lived in Hull¹ with 293,019 patients are registered with General Practices in Hull². Nine in ten (89.7%) of Hull residents were White British (94.1% White)³.

Life expectancy at birth in Hull is 76.6 years for men and 80.5 years for women (79.5 years for men and 83.2 years for women for England)⁴.

Hull is ranked as the third most deprived local authority out of 326⁵.

High smoking prevalence, alcohol and substance misuse, poor educational attainment and lack of employment opportunities all impact on the health of Hull's population.
